ArCr mission is Promotion & Print sales, Courtroom Sketch Artist and Portrait Painting.

In the year 2022 Arlene lost her speech and had to use a foam tube to hold a paint brush with Carl as her CareGiver . We started going to 'The Sunday Call' a weekly 3+ hour zoom sessions of www.HealingALS.org that at the end of the zoom session has breakout rooms where one with ALS can talk to other ALSers across the world . After The Call we would Face Time & email exchange with other ALSers through the week and started doing what they were doing . And it work \sim with Arlene's fingers grabbing the oil stick .

June 14th ~ to grab an oil stick and started The Girl in a Red Dress sketch.

July 1st ~ completed The Girl in a Red Dress sketch.

July $3rd \sim Arlene$ spoke her 1st word in the morning and through out the day could only speak one word at a time .

July $3rd \sim Arlene$ started The Girl with a Pearl Earring sketch in the same sketch pad as The Girl in a Red Dress sketch and completed the sketch on the same day she started the sketch.

July 10th ~ Arlene could put her eye drops in by herself before going to bed for the night.

July $25\text{th} \sim \text{Arlene}$ could put toothpaste on her toothbrush by herself before going to bed for the night .

September $3rd \mid$ the start of Labor Day weekend ~ Arlene was speaking complete sentences , her voice was soft sounding of her natural voice and NOT sounding like her ALS voice before she lost her voice .



September 11th \sim on The Sunday HealingALS Call in the breakout room , after the main session on zoom platform , Arlene was carrying on a conversation with three other ALS families across the U.S. and we exchanged email addresses , to get with each other durning the next week .

September 13th ~ Arlene Creates promotion & print sales ~ live on by Carl setting a Missouri LLC that is called Carl Creates . Arlene & Carl are joint members of PPAM with our dues paid till January of year 2024 . PPAMidwest is a regional affiliate , Kansas ~ Missouri ~ Nebraska , of PPAI Promotional Products Association International .




